## WYONG PUBLIC SCHOOL SWIMMING CARNIVAL

The swimming carnival is deemed a school day for all primary children. This year the carnival will once again be held at **Wyong Olympic Pool**.

You have two choices on how to transport your child to and from the carnival.

- 1. Parents may drop students directly at the pool between 9.00am and 9:30am. No student is to arrive at the pool before this time.
- 2. For those parents who are unable to transport their child to the pool a bus will be leaving the school at 9:10am sharp.

If your child requires transport to and from the pool you will need to return the permission slip by Wednesday, 15<sup>th</sup> February 2023.

## **COVID-19 Safety Information:**

Parents are able to attend the carnival however, must abide the 1.5m social distancing rules. Parents must stay on grassed areas and are **NOT** to be in the grandstand area. This is due to keeping our social distancing procedure with the pool venue. **Any person displaying symptoms should not attend the carnival, including students, parents, staff and spectators.** 

WHEN:

Monday, 20th February 2023

TIME:

Bus leaving school at 9.10am to return to school by 2.30pm

Private transport students are to be dropped off no earlier than 9.00am

WHERE:

Wyong Olympic Pool

TRANSPORT:

Bus or Private

COST:

No cost to Wyong Public School students. This will be covered by the school. **Spectators will need to pay \$3.30 to gain entry to the Wyong Pool at the pool gate**. Students and parents are NOT permitted to use fitness passport to enter the pools for a swimming carnival. This is a condition of membership by Fitness

Passport not the pool's, or our, decision.

WHO:

All children in Years 3-6, and any Year 2 child who is eight years old this year

and can swim 50m may attend.

WHAT TO BRING:

Swimmers, broad brimmed hat, sunscreen, t-shirt (no singlets), towel, change of

clothes and shoes, plenty of water, lunch and recess. (Or money if you are

planning to buy lunch from the kiosk.)

No crepe paper or body paint is permitted near the pool

Goggles (if needed)

Swimming cap (if needed can be purchased on the day in house colours for \$5.00

but must have correct money)

**CLOSING DATE:** 

Complete the permission note and return by Wednesday, 15th February 2023.

Whilst we encourage every child to go in at least one event, we do realise that some children do not have the necessary skills to swim competitively. Novelty 20m races will be made available to students in Years 3-6 who are unable to confidently swim 50m.

ALL YEAR 3-6 TEACHERS WILL BE AT THE POOL FOR SAFETY REASONS. THERE WILL BE NO REGULAR YEAR 3-6 CLASSES AT SCHOOL.

Several teachers have been assigned to be lifeguards and other teachers will provide extra supervision. Whilst there is shade for the children to sit under at the pool, it is mandatory that <u>ALL</u> students wear a broad brimmed hat and t-shirt (no singlets) to the carnival.
